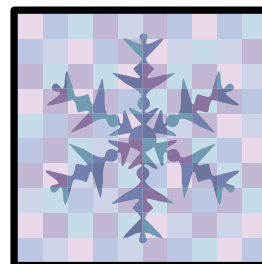
## Collection

## Snow procedure
