Welcome back

Reading

We are obviously working hard in school to do this but one way all parents can help is the simplest way - hear your child read every night. If you can't hear them read ask them questions about their book – the story - the characters – what they think is going to happen. Reading is so important – if they cannot read they cannot access anything else. This will continue to be a focus of homework activities for this term



Vocabulary

As well as the promotion of reading another target for the school is to make the school vocabulary rich. One of the ideas we had to help us improve this was introducing our own Dallington high street outside the Dallington classroom. The signs are fantastic and will be used by many classes as a starting point for role play, investigations and conversations.

Warming up homeless


