### **Lateness**

Last Wednesday we had our School Improvement partner visit the school for her termly visit. She was shocked that at 9:10am we still had 6 children come in. When asked by Mrs CB why they were late two children ignored her and walked round to class. Lateness is not acceptable and rudeness certainly is not. As I mentioned last month all lateness is recorded and counts towards your child's attendance. Mrs CB will ask your child or you why you are late. We understand that everyone runs late occasionally but it is the same families that are late every day. School starts at 9am – that means teaching starts at 9am. If you are dropping off your child at 9;10am they are missing close to 15 minutes of input- this means the teacher has to recap which disrupts the rest of the class which is not fair on those children who have turned up on time.

Lateness = lost learning (Figures below are calculated over a school year)		
5 minutes late each day	3 days lost	
10 minutes late each day	6.5 days lost	
15 minutes late each day	10 days lost	
20 minutes late each day	13 days lost	
30 minutes late each day	19 days lost	

So far, across the year, if we add all of the lateness – children have lost a combined 39 hours of education- this is not acceptable or conducive to a strong start to their education. Please ensure your child is at school on time.
