Literacy

The children will learn to develop an understanding of what has been read to them by retelling stories using their own words and any newly learned vocabulary.

We will focus on learning our phonics sounds and begin to segment and blend to read consonant, vowel, consonant words (i.e. sat)

The children will be focusing on their fine motor skills this term to help them with their letter formation and pencil grip.

We will be focusing on books about starting school, overcoming obstacles and trying new things.

Expressive arts and design

We encourage the children to be imaginative and to explore and use different media and materials every day. The children will also be able to express their ideas through dance and music and through role play opportunity in our home corner and playhouse.

Communication and language

This term we are focusing on getting the children to listen and respond with relevant questions.

Physical Development

This term, our main focus will be on developing the children's Fine and Gross motor skills. We will be doing lots of threading, weaving, pouring, crawling and climbing to develop these to allow us to be ready to write and improve our overall strength

RE

Numeracy

In Numeracy, our focus is on developing a deep understanding of number and numerical pattern, which will give the children a strong foundation for mathematics. This term, we will be developing our subitising and counting skills, and will be exploring the composition of numbers within five, learning to spot smaller numbers 'hiding' inside larger numbers. We will begin to compare sets of objects and use the language of comparison in learning and play.

To develop the children's understanding of the world they will be; drawing and writing about our families; drawing maps of our journey to school and finding out more about where we live and our school through first-hand observational walks and investigations within the school.
