

English

In English, we will be following Jane Considine's Write Stuff lessons helping to develop children's writing. The children will be starting with a narrative unit, based on the book Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura. We will then move on to writing a holiday brochure for Skara Brae.



Music

We will be starting our music learning this year by taking inspiration from STOMP performances and experimenting with everyday objects to create music. Near_Christmas, we will be learning songs to be performed during the Christmas Carol Concert.



<u>PE</u>

This term, we will be having PE sessions on a Thursday, which will focus on gymnastics. Jess (specialist P.E teacher) will be leading these.



Maths

We will start by adding and subtracting across ten before moving onto place value and numbers up to 1000. We will focus on manipulating the additive relationship and securing mental calculations. Term 2 will have a focus on column addition and subtraction.

Within our fluency lessons, we will be focusing on the commutative law, doubles of numbers to 10 and the 3 and 8 times tables.

<u>MfL</u>

In French we will be beginning to learn greetings and classroom phrases. We will then move onto numbers and age.



Computing

In computing we will be looking at Computing Systems and Networks focusing on how computers and networks are connected. In term 2, we will be designing and creating our very own stop-frame animations!



Art/DT

In Art (term 1), we will be focusing on the skill of drawing. We will use cave art as inspiration to create our very own cave drawings, using natural colours to enhance them.

In DT (term 2), we will be covering Food Technology. For this project, we will design and make a seasonal tart for our school lunch.



<u>RE</u>

In term 1, we will be focusing on The Christian creation story. What do Christians learn from the Creation story?

In term 2, the key question will be How and why do the people mark the significant events of life?



<u>Science</u>

In Science (Term 1), we will be focusing on the unit 'light'. Children will notice that light is reflected of surfaces, learn how to protect their eyes from the sun and create shadow puppets to recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object

In term 2, our focus will be 'sound'. Children will recognise how vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear, find patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it.

History/Geography

This term history is our main focus. Our topic will be Time Travel and so we will be exploring how life changed from the Stone Age to the Iron Age. We will be focusing on food & farming, housing & structures, religion and culture through the three time periods (Stone, Bronze and Iron).
