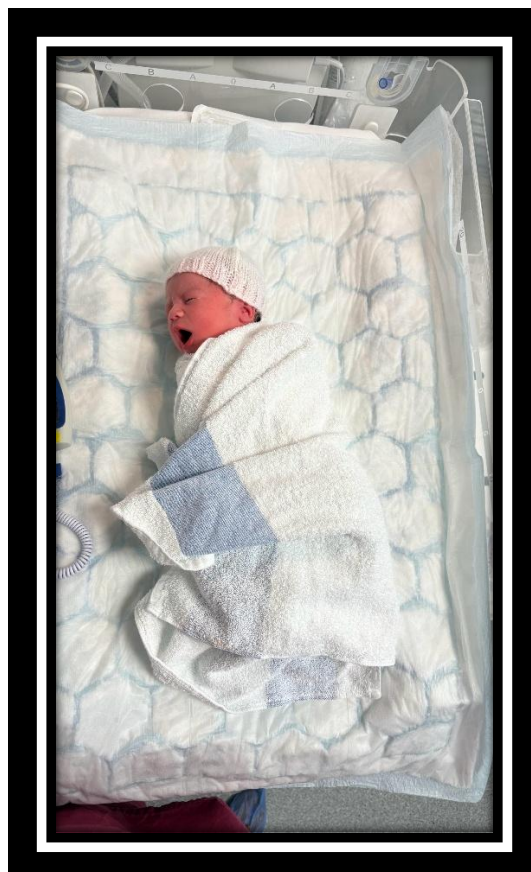
Open the box company
