

This is a busy term as the Year 1 children have their national Phonics Screening and the Year 2's are securing their learning in preparation for our school Year 2 assessments.

It cannot be underestimated the huge impact reading with your child everyday has on all aspects of their learning. Reading can be with their Guided Reading book, a library book or a much-loved home book.

Science

We will be learning about the differences between bulbs and seeds, the parts of a plant and the conditions that a plant needs to grow.



Music

Through a range of musical styles we will continue to practice moving to the beat, singing, playing percussion instruments confidently and begin to compose our own music.

Computing

We will be using a range of computer programs to support our learning.



R.E.

We continue to explore what it means to belong to a faith community, including exploring symbols, traditions and places of worship from Christianity, Judaism and Islam.

English

Phonics is an important daily lesson as it supports a child with their reading and writing. The children will be given games and sheets that you can do at home to support the learning in school and continue to build their confidence. We will be using a variety of stories to base our writing on, starting with The Dragon Machine. The focus will be to confidently use punctuation and write sentences with adjectives and time adverbials.



Maths

Year 1's will be developing their addition fluency within 20 and their recall of subtraction facts within 10. They will also be learning about money including coin recognition to add simple amounts. Any real-life experiences using coins would be fantastic. They will also be learning about position and direction.

Year 2's will be learning about division in relation to multiplication facts. Addition and subtraction of two-digit numbers, e.g. $34 + 21 =$ and $59 - 27 =$. They will also be learning about Fractions, Money and Time!
